

## PARENTS / GUARDIANS CODE OF CONDUCT

- Encourage your child to learn the rules and participate within them.
- Be familiar with and encourage your child to adhere to the Discipline and Safety Policy and to abide by the Anti-bullying Policy.
- Help your child to recognise good performance and not just the results.
- Set a good example by recognising good sportsmanship, applauding all performances.
- Recognize and agree to enforce the Photography and Videoing Policy.
- Ensure punctuality when "dropping off" at the start and "collecting" at the end of your child's gymnastics lesson.
- If you are to be unavoidably late for collection of your child, please attempt to contact and inform the coaches at the club so that adequate supervision can be provided. (Lindsay mobile: 07801 731022).
- Please ensure that your child and the coaches are informed if children are to be collected by someone other than their normal guardian.
- Please ensure that your child is "dropped off" and "collected" from within the building. Children are **not** permitted to leave the building to enter the car park without a responsible person.
- Always ensure that your child is dressed appropriately for their gymnastics lesson.
  - Long hair should be tied away from face.
- If wishing to observe the gymnastics / trampoline lesson please use the kitchen and view through the hatch at Landford.
- If your child is unable to attend gymnastics and is likely to miss two or more lessons due to illness, injury or holiday, please inform Lindsay.
- Endeavor to pay the "gymnastics fee" prior to start of new term or within two weeks.
- Should you wish to raise any concerns regarding your child's gymnastics / trampoline lesson or your child's performance please contact Lindsay directly.
